

Boat Race. make two simple sailboats. Cut out a triangle of paper to be a sail and then secure it to half a kebab stick using Blu-Tack or sticky tape. Secure the kebab stick to the roof of a toy car with a large piece of Blu-Tack. You will also need one balloon for each child/car

Mark a finish line using masking tape or a length of rope. Then using an inflated (but not tied) balloon direct the air coming out, at the sail to race the car to the finish line. If a boat falls over, turn it up right where it fell so that the race can continue. The first across the finish line wins.

You could play several rounds of the game depending on the time available; include some obstacles in subsequent rounds if the first one is too easy. Remind the children that in today's true story from the Bible Paul's ship was being blown in lots of different directions by the strong winds, but he trusted God, and when the storm broke the ship apart God rescued everyone – just as he had promised!
