



Memory Stone

1. Whilst out on a walk, see if you can find a stone that would be good to paint. Warning don't take stones from anyone else's garden. A good stone would fit comfortably in a grown-up hand, and have a past of a surface that is smooth, though it might be a bit rounded.
2. When you get home wash the stone well and let it dry completely. While your stone is drying have a think what you want to put on it. The purpose is to remind you about how God is there for you.
3. If you have paints, you could paint on your design, or you can use sharpie pens (Thick markers) to draw on your design. There are some designs above, you can be colourful or you could use simple line drawings.
4. Once the stone is dry, put it somewhere that it can remind you about God, just as Samuel built an Altar to God,
