



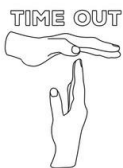
Thinking it through

Is there a time when you have faced difficulty, and wondered if God noticed or cared? You can be sure that He did see and care, but He doesn't act the way we want, because He knows what is best for us.

What do you learn about who is in control? Why did Job not turn away from God? When are you tempted to turn away? How can this passage help you to trust God in those times?



Take some time out with God, you could write him a letter or poem about how things are for you right now. If you don't want to write maybe you could record something for God, just between you and Him.
