The information in the spring term interim report reported on the most up to date attainment and targets. In the end of year report, we will be reporting more on the children's attitude to learning, and personal and social development. The requirement to report on attendance for the academic year has been removed but we will provide an overall percentage taken from September until 20<sup>th</sup> March 2020.
