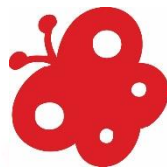


EYFS INTENT

Aims

The Early Years Foundation Stage is based on these three themes:
A Unique Child + Positive Relationships + Enabling Environments =
Learning and Development

The curriculum is broken down into 3 Prime Areas and 4 Specific Areas of learning. These are then further broken down into 17 aspects.
