










<p>Science </p> <p>In the Animal Survival project your child will learn about growth in animals by exploring the life cycles of some familiar animals. They will build on their learning about the survival of humans by identifying the basic needs of animals for survival, including food, water, air and shelter. In the Pull and Push project your child will learn about three types of mechanism: sliders, levers and linkages. They will make models of each mechanism before designing and making a greetings card with a moving part</p>	<p>English Children will continue to receive daily phonics lessons. This will support both their reading, and spelling skills. As well as the opportunity to select individual reading books the children will participate in guided sessions that aim to develop their understanding of different texts.</p> <p>Fiction: Your child will be using historical knowledge of a significant sovereign to write a comic strip.</p> <p>Non-Fiction: Your child will be using Historical Knowledge to write an Information Leaflet for Hampton Court Place </p> <p>Poetry: Your child will be writing poems made from kennings about significant sovereign</p>	<p>Mathematics 3</p> <p>In the Fractions unit, your child will learn to both recognise and find unit/ non-unit fractions of shapes and amounts.</p> <p>In the Time unit, your child will learn to read and record the time to o'clock and half an hour then to quarter past and quarter to.</p> <p>In the Statistics unit, your child will learn to collate data in tally charts, tables and block diagrams. They will then learn to draw and interpret pictograms with scales 2, 5 and 10.</p> <p>In the Position and Direction unit, your child will learn to use positional language, describe movement and direction.</p>

What makes some places sacred to believers?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Magnificent Monarchs</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Summer Term 2024 Years 1 & 2 Miss Spain & Mrs Delrosa</p> 	<p>History & Geography </p> <p>The Magnificent Monarchs project teaches your child about the English and British monarchy from AD 871 to the present day. Using timelines, information about royal palaces, portraits and other historical sources, they will build up an understanding of the monarchs and then research six of the most significant sovereigns.</p>
<p>Physical, Social, Health Education</p> <p>In the Rights and Respect Unit your child will learn about getting on with others, how to manage angry feelings, to identify safe adults and how to remain safe online. They also learn about managing money and caring for our environment </p>	<p>Computing: Information Technology</p> <p>In the Animated Story Books unit your child will learn to use a program such as 2Create-a-story. They will learn how to add sound, pictures and text. Then they will save and learn how to find their own work.</p> <p>Music: </p> <p>In the Friendship Song unit your child will learn about singing and playing together in an ensemble. As well as learning to sing, play, improvise and compose with this song, child will listen and appraise other songs about friendship. This Reflect, Rewind, Replay unit consolidates your child's learning from the year. They will revisit songs and musical activities, building knowledge of the History of Music and the beginnings of the Language of Music.</p>	<p>Physical Education </p> <p>In the Games for understanding unit your child will learn about the principles of attack and defence. They will apply these in a game. In the Dodging unit your child will learn to explore and develop dodging skills; before applying in a game situation.</p> <p>Design Technology:</p> <p>In the Cut, Stitch, and Join project your child will learn about fabric home products and the significant British brand Cath Kidston. They will learn about sewing patterns and using a running stitch and embellishments before making a sewn bag tag.</p> <p>Art & Design: </p> <p>In the Portraits and Poses project your child will learn about portraiture. They will analyse the portraits of Tudor monarchs and compare Tudor portraits and selfies today. They will use photo editing software to create royal portraits.</p>
