Climate Action Group

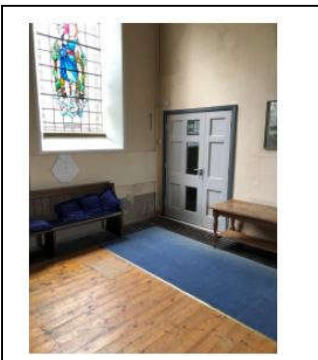
