Uniform and Warm Clothing

As you are aware our risk assessment and guidance requires a good source of ventilation and fresh air in classrooms and work spaces. We do not expect these to be in line with the school uniform policy, however, we do expect them to wear their school uniform as normal and for these items to be additional if needed.

Remote Learning Update

As the national roll out of remote learning continues, our staff are continuing to develop their knowledge and skills through ongoing training for Google Classroom.

We have now introduced Google Classroom to the children and will shortly be releasing to you a parent's guide and your child's log in. In the meantime, the children are getting used to using this more regularly within the school setting to support our every-day teaching and learning and learning how to use different aspects in preparation for home learning if needed at any time.

Unfortunately, we are still waiting for our additional devices as we are informed that there continues to be a national shortage in availability. Fingers crossed it won't be too long!

School Photographs

The school photographer is scheduled to come into school on the morning of Monday 16th November. We have carried out a risk assessment and we are able to have the photographer in school under current guidelines. On this occasion, only children in school will be photographed, no additional siblings who do not attend Danby School, will be able to be included this time.
