### **Staffing Update**

As I am sure you are aware we have a couple of members of staff not able to attend school at the moment. This has predominantly been due to the Covid Test and Trace and the requirements for self-isolation on different family units, however we have today received notification that a member of our school community has tested positive. Please see the accompanying letter which we have been asked to share with you on behalf of the DfE.

As you will see from the attached letter, the DfE has provided us with direct advice and guidance and are happy that we are safe to continue as normal, and that currently, we have sufficient numbers of staff to ensure that we can continue to run safely with all year groups in school.

Following advice from NYCC, I will be changing my working timetable from this week. I will now work alternate weeks, instead of alternate days, to minimise the risk of cross-infection between the two schools. This then allows for a 48 hour break between the schools at the weekend. Next week I will be at Danby School.
