

# **Adverse Psychiatric Effects of Medicines and Anaesthetics**

**..... preventing avoidable harm**

- Up to 30% of adverse drug reactions (ADRs) are neuropsychiatric
- Depression, self-harm, aggression, psychosis, suicide, dementia may be ADRs & prevention is possible for these and other iatrogenic disease
- ADRs after anaesthetics are not researched or analysed
- Adverse events & ADRs in NHS hospitals cost estimated £2 billion a year & contribute to thousands of deaths
