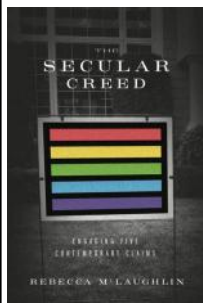

Sunday 5.00pm | Evening Prayer

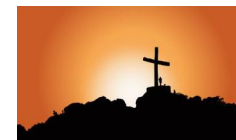

This year, Transform Europe Network (TEN) marks 30 years of the Harvest for the Hungry Campaign, raising funds to provide food parcels for helping children and families trapped in poverty in some of the poorest parts of Europe. When Harvest for the Hungry started 30 years ago, churches, schools and individuals put together food parcels, which were driven across to Europe in large lorries for our partners to distribute to hungry families. In recent years it has been more cost effective to raise funds in the UK and for food items to be purchased by our partners in their own countries.

Thank you so much for your involvement with 'Harvest for the Hungry' over many years. This year, TEN will again put together special resources, to enable you and your church to get involved in our 'Harvest for the Hungry' appeal 2022. We'd love it if you are able to get involved by running a harvest supper, service, or special fundraising event during the year.

We would be delighted if you are able to attend our special launch event at Crofts End Church, Bristol on Wednesday 27th April. Please encourage others at your church to do so. We will be hearing from Partners about how 30 years of Harvest appeals has impacted lives in Eastern Europe. We will have a live interview with Derek Wade, who helped to establish Harvest for the Hungry in the 1990s, Slavko Hadzic will share a special recorded message for this event, plus live worship from Loulita Gill.

You are invited to stay after the event to meet the TEN team over complimentary refreshments. (The café will be available on arrival if you wish to purchase refreshments.)

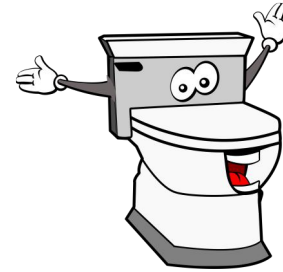
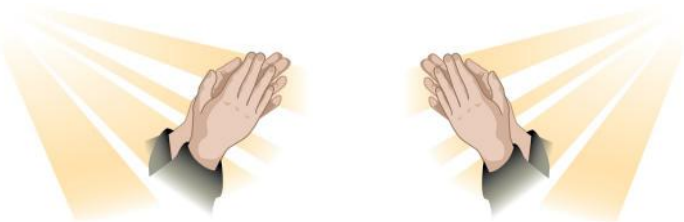
