Testimonial Letter

We received the following word of testimony from a converted Roman Catholic named Robert Franz Militello, which we trust will prove to be a blessing to the reader.

Dear Brother Ruckman, point soldier in the service of our Lord Jesus Christ:

How thankful we are to God for your dogmatic defense of His word in the King James Version.

I had written you once before, and thank you kindly for your reply. I had written that as a combat soldier in World War II, I married a German girl I met during patrol several months before the end of the war. Our marriage was done secretly according to international law, despite the fraternization ban. Our son, Robert Franz Militello was born July 26th, 1946. Our love story received tremendous publicity in the press and radio, internationally. It is a deep story; however, it was later in years that I realized its manifestation. My son was the very first registered in all Europe as a U.S. citizen born of a combat G.I. My wife and son arrived in the USA in November, 1946, just 3½ months after his birth. The efforts involved to get him here involved politicians, General Eisenhower, and finally, the State Department, and General Clay.

Robert was educated in a Catholic elementary school. I was Catholic, of Italian descent, carrying the badge of ignorance and the yoke of tradition. My wife Kathe was Evangelisch. Robert was later educated in a private school of Jesuits. He later received a bachelor's degree in Journalism, and a master's degree in political science. He was politically active as a personal supporter and writer for the new governor of New York, Mario Cuomo. In his early thirties, Robert quit politics and blamed the hypocrisy, deception, and fraud. Right after he was born again, he dove into the King James Version with a drive and energy that was, and still is, relentless. His ripping into the politics of the Jesuits appeared in Chick Publications, the Church Magazine in London, England, and Liverpool. His taped sermons have flooded Texas. He appeared as a guest preacher in Bible Baptist Church in Missouri. He makes his living in civil service for the City of New York. He resides in his small, one family home in Brooklyn, New York, and has a small congregation in his basement church. He is always out every Saturday street preaching. He appeared in St. Albans Evangelical Missionary preaching with fire where 300 black Christians listened. Bob and I were the only white Christians there. The blacks call him John the Baptist, but I call him the second German Martin Luther. Robert has four children, Gregory, 16, Kathyrine, 13, Joshua, 4, and Elissa, 1. Robert is one of my three children. I have 2 daughters who have children. All in all, Kathe and me have 11 grandchildren. Although my son was saved, I was born again in my fifties. Thank God all my children and grandchildren are saved, and reared as Bible believing Christians. I am retired, and now live on Jones Road, Round Top, New York, 12473, about 40 miles south of Albany. My wife and I lead a simple life seeking first the kingdom of God every day in our remaining years.

God bless you, sir. Its an honor to be given access to our fight for our Lord, and to join you in every skirmish. Let the non-believers hear and join or blow their rebellion out of their barracks bag. Yours in "Jesus Christ,"

Explanatory Note:

Sergeant Daniel Militello, now with the Lord, saw combat in France and Germany with the US Army 2nd Armoured Division in WW2, US Seventh Army. In 2013, aged 92, he was awarded the Knight of the Legion of Honour medal at an award ceremony conducted by the Deputy Consul General of France. Sergeant Militello was cited for having taken part in the liberation of France.
