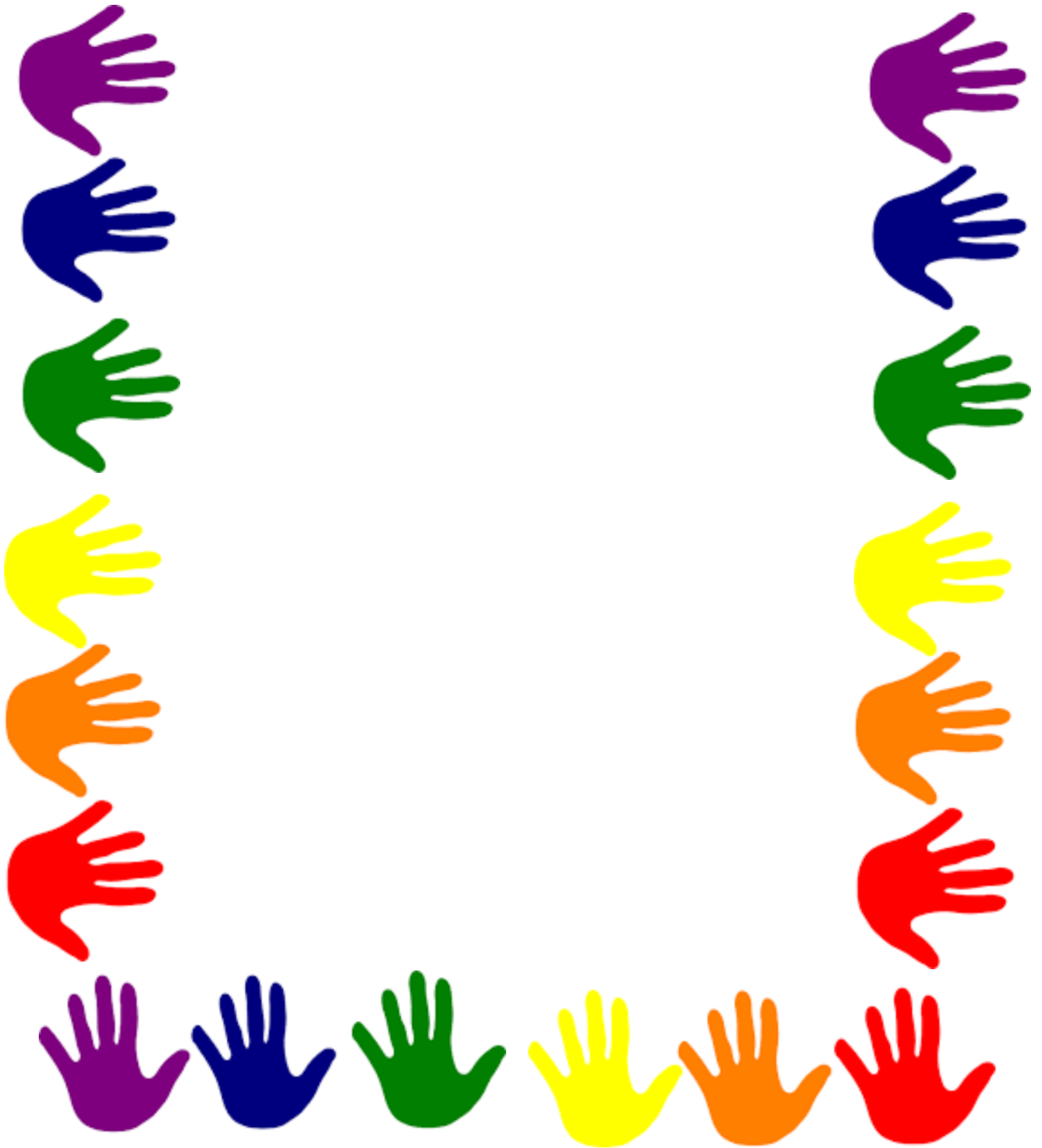
Maundy Thursday

When they arrived he washed their feet.



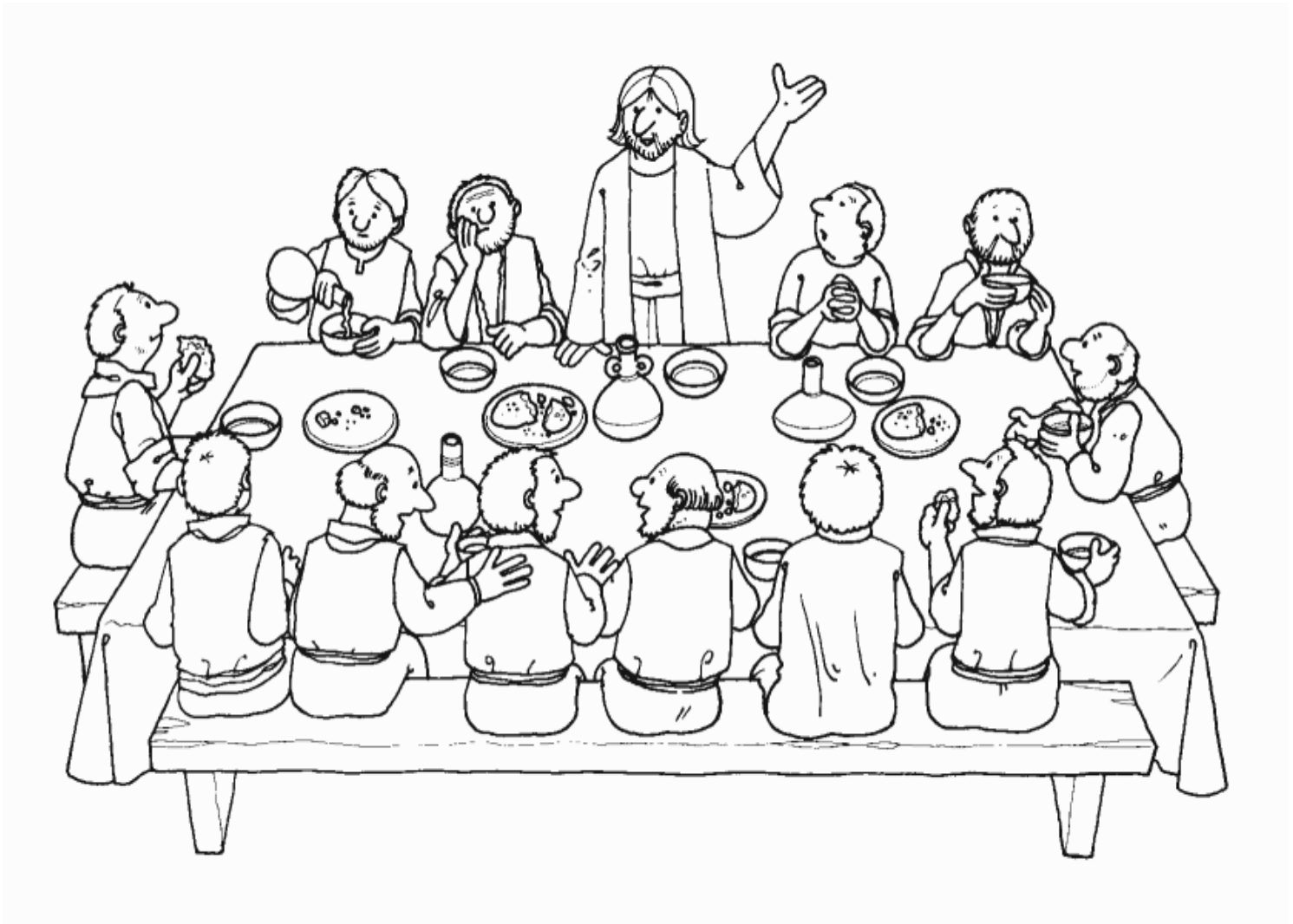
He showed them that they must help

After the meal Jesus was worried and he went into the garden to pray.

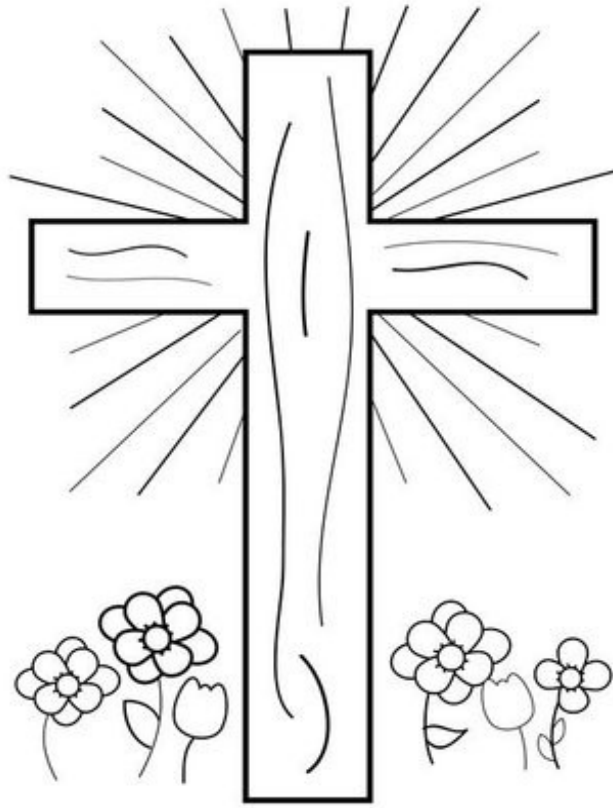


Soldiers came and took him away.

Good Friday



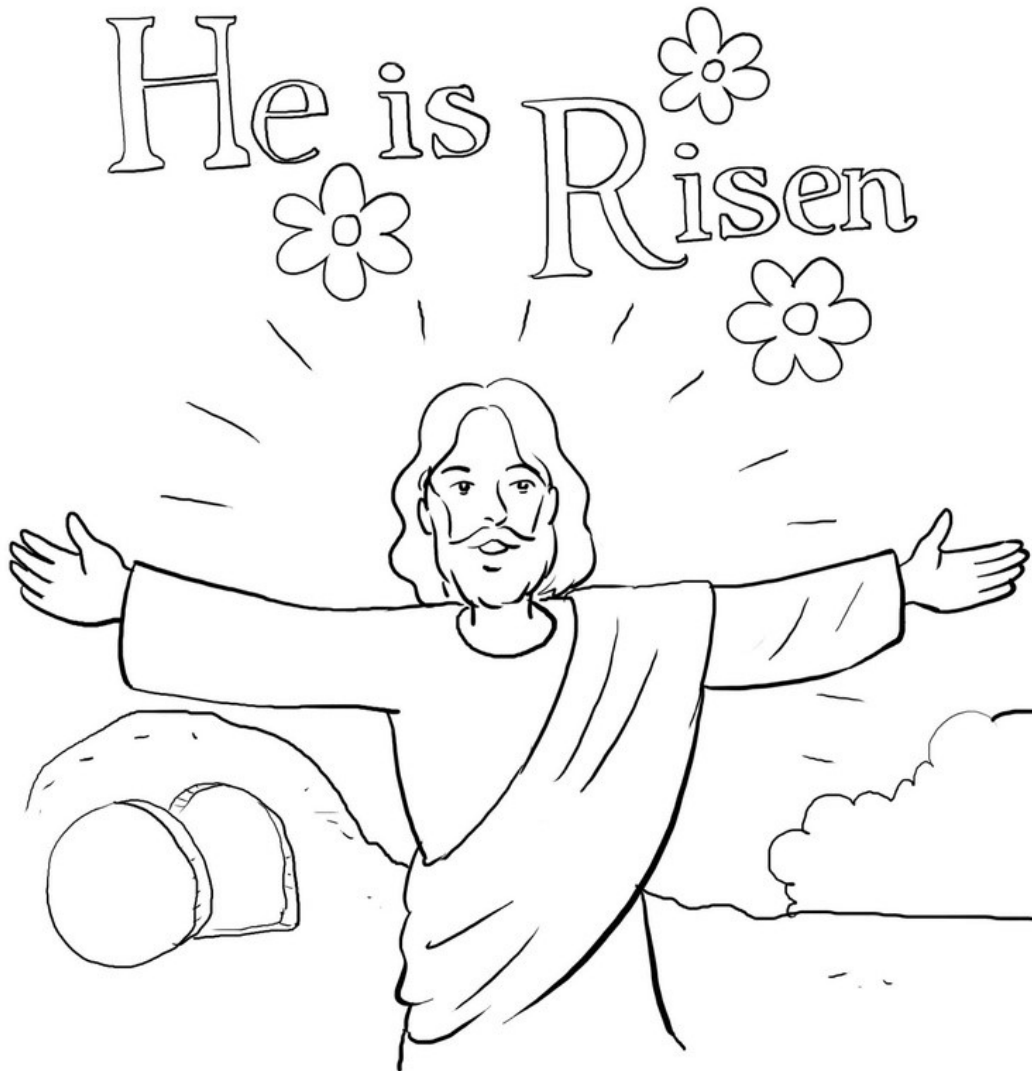
Jesus died on the cross;
