Your continued generosity has enabled us to complete two major projects. The Parish Room refurbishment is complete and the newly named de Lacy Centre, now in regular use, opened in October. Fundraising donations continued through 2021 towards our 'Reimagining our Ministry' appeal and having raised enough funds for the project, we have now installed the new equipment which was used for the first time in March.

Reflect. Revive. Rejoice.


Reflect. Revive. Rejoice is the theme for the Cathedral in 2022. Throughout the year we will be hosting services and events which explore this theme.

Cathedral Income and Expenditure for 2022



The effect of the Covid-19 pandemic on the Cathedral's finances has been severe. As a result of the restrictions and closures in place, it has been difficult for people to give their offering and as a Cathedral we need to think carefully about our finances and what we can achieve in terms of mission, outreach, and

worship. We receive an annual grant from the Church Commissioners but it is important to note that this does not cover all costs to support the work of the Cathedral. We are very much dependent on grants and, crucially, on the voluntary income that comes from regular giving by members of our worshipping community.

I am therefore inviting you to review your giving to Bradford Cathedral.

The income figures mentioned do not include some of our ambitions for the future such as:

- **A significant programme of repair and refurbishment to the Cathedral and estate**
- **Improvements to Cathedral Close properties**
- **Work to begin improving access to the Cathedral**
- **Securing funds to further develop our music, education and events programme**

This **Renewal of Giving Campaign** is about reflecting on financial giving and prayerfully making a decision – as individuals – as to what we are able to contribute to help ensure that the Cathedral can flourish as a living Christian community for today, tomorrow, and the years to come. I understand everyone's circumstances are different and I invite you to pray, reflect and make your decision on how best to support the Cathedral. Your giving helps to make the life, ministry and mission of the Cathedral possible. Your generosity enables us to be a truly welcoming Christian community for Bradford and Yorkshire.
