Music plays a very important part in the worship at St Michael's and central to this is the organ and our regular choir, which includes talented musicians and singers, several of whom are members of local or national choirs and choral societies.

Over the years the choir has enhanced many services with performances of specially written pieces in addition to more traditional liturgical music. Amersham Music Festival has chosen on many occasions to hold a Festival Eucharist in the church, where Sung Masses by composers such as Mozart and Bach have been performed by a special Festival Choir. New members, especially boys and girls aged 7 upwards, are always welcome. Please contact the Parish Administrator for details. Choir practice takes place every Wednesday evening from 7 p.m. to 8.15 p.m. and on Sunday at 9.10 a.m., before the service.

Choir Festivals, school carol concerts, organ recitals and a Musicathon event have all enriched the musical life of the church. At all these events our wonderful and recently-restored Walker organ has played a major role in accompanying the performances.
