A reminder of the new rules on COVID and school attendance

Positive cases are beginning to rise in and around our school community; it is important to remember our response to these positive cases is now different. We no longer act as track and trace as this role is handled by the NHS. Absences for COVID are only authorised now if your child is symptomatic and waiting on the results of a PCR test, or your child is positive with COVID.

Restrictions on the requirement to self-isolate as a close contact of someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 have been removed for children under 18.5 years and for the double jabbed. If someone tests positive in your household, the other members (if under 18.5 or double jabbed) do not need to stay at home and children can go to school. However, those children should take a PCR test at the earliest opportunity – if the result is positive they must isolate at home, if negative, they can return to school
