SMALL GROUP SERMON DISCUSSION

- If you are able, meet virtually as a small group through the various free online conference resources such as Microsoft teams, Skype, Zoom etc.
- Personally, take some time through the week to quietly reflect and go through the questions on your own and apply the message to your life.

Discussion Questions:

1. Read Psalm 139:7-10. How does that make you feel that God is everywhere?
2. Why do you think the most common emotional pain in our society is loneliness?
3. What are some of the ways God deals with our issue of loneliness? (See some of the verses under point 1) How have you personally experienced that yourself? How can we be more sensitive to people who could be lonely and seek to help and encourage them?
4. Read Daniel 3:16-18. How do these verses show that fatalism (what will be will be) is unbiblical and that absolute confidence in God, no matter what happens, is true faith?
5. How can we live the kind of lives where we live each day with total confidence in God? Why does that change or can change when we go through difficult times in our lives?
6. How have you found 2 Corinthians 10:13 to be true in your own life?
7. How has the presence of God seen you through when you feel discouraged? See Psalm 34:18, John 14:16, Isaiah 43:2.
