 and discuss the questions with your husband/wife/family. If you are on your
 own, arrange to ring another person and chat through the questions over the
 phone or Skype etc.
- If you are able, meet virtually as a small group through the various free online conference resources such as Microsoft teams, Skype, Zoom etc.
- Personally, take some time through the week to quietly reflect and go through the questions on your own and apply the message to your life.

Discussion Questions:

1. Before you start to dig into this study, how would you describe God's power in your own words?

- 2. Look up these verses of how Jesus displayed God's power: Over nature (Mark 4:36-41, Matthew 21:19, John 2:7) Over illness (Luke 5:27) Over death (Luke 7:11-15) Over satan (Luke 8;27-39). What do you see and how does it encourage you?
- 3. Read Ephesians 1:20. Don't miss how stunning this verse is. How would you explain this verse to help a fellow Christian who feels powerless in their life?
- 4. Read Isaiah 40:28-31. Because God's power is unlimited, He never gets tired. He never gets weary. What does that mean to you in your life right now?
- 5. To access Gods power, we need to believe in faith, see Mark 9:23 and Matthew 9:29. If that is true, and it is, how would you answer these two questions? 1. What are you expecting God to do <u>in</u> your life? 2. What are you expecting God to do <u>through</u> your life?
- 6. A goal is a statement of faith. When I set a goal and I say, "I believe God can help me do this, whatever 'this' is, by that time" it's simply a statement of faith. What godly goals have you personally set and seen God make them happen?
- 7. Why does God want us to step out in faith before He acts and releases His power in our lives? See Joshua 3:15-16 for an example of this principle.
