1. Read John 16:32 We must always be aware that God is with us, but what are symptoms of not knowing that? How can we demonstrate our knowledge that God is with us?

2. Read John 12:49. We must let God help us choose our words, but how can we let God help us do this? What are examples of situations where God’s help choosing our words could be important?

3. What problems in life can be caused by trying to please everyone? What is wrong with that? How would your life be different if you lived out John 5:30?

4. We must depend on God’s power, but how can we know whether we’re depending on our own power instead of God’s power?

5. Read Matthew 5:44. We must love those who hurt us, but why would God command us to love our enemies?

6. To think like Jesus we need to know exactly who we are, but why could people be confused about knowing who they are? What kind of fake life might we live if we don’t know who we are?

7. Read John 10:14-15 We must be willing to sacrifice for others, but what does that look like in today’s world? What could giving my life away for God look like?

8. Read John 6:38. We must do God’s will instead of our own will, but what is an example of doing what God wants instead of what I want?
