- 3. We may not realize it at the time, but according to James 1:15, what happens to us inside when we sin? Why is that?
- 4. Read Isaiah 59:2. Sin stands in the way of communicating with those who love you. What are some of the roadblocks that exist in your relationship with God? And with others?
- 5. The whole point of rethinking sin is to get to the place where we can break free from its hold. Read 1 Peter 2:24 and 2 Corinthians 13:4. What do these scriptures say to you?
- 6. We often think our sin only hurts ourselves. But why is this never really true? How can our sin hurt others, either now or in the future?
- 7. How can reflecting on our sin be beneficial in helping us to turn around?
