1. Read Ecclesiastes 8:6. Discuss what you think the author means by the importance of the right timing and the right way of doing things in your life.

2. Read Psalm 119:60. Delayed obedience is

disobedience, and that to hurry is good when it is related to obeying God. What has God told you to do that you haven't promptly done? Share some examples with your group.

3. Read Proverbs 19:2. We should not move fast in all that we do in life; there are times when going slow is ideal. Discuss as a group the importance of being patient and when it is prudent to slow down. Share an area where you need to slow down.

4. Read James 1:19. This verse is often quoted but not always easy to apply. There can be times when it is difficult to put these principles into practice. Share with your group situations in your life when it is hard for you to follow these steps and what makes it difficult for you.

5. Read Ecclesiastes 3:1-5 and Habakkuk 2:3. Discuss what God tells us in his word about his timing. Share your experience with God's timing in your life; how do you trust even when it seems to take a long time?

6. Pray 1 Kings 8:58 together in your group and ask the Holy Spirit to guide you and keep you aware of the signposts and path the Lord has cleared for you. Discuss what you are doing or plan to do to stay centred on God and focused on your path through the year, while being aware of the rhythms and pace he wants you to keep.
