**4. I am eternally secure in my salvation because I have the  
possession of \_\_\_\_\_.**

*'And hope does not disappoint us, because God has poured out his love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom he has given us.'* Romans 5:5 NIV

*'For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God.'* Romans 8:14 NLT

*'But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.'* Romans 5:8 NIV

6. Read Romans 5:10b. How and why can we rejoice?
