5. If you are a Christian Jesus is not ashamed to call you his brother and sister, to identify with you. Why is that?

6. The Bible says in Romans 8:1 that there is no condemnation when you are in Christ Jesus. How should that affect the way you feel about yourself? How should it affect the way you act and live each day?

7. What does Philippians 4:13 mean to you personally and how can you apply that to every day life or a situation you are facing at the moment?
