New Year's Message Listening to God's voice 2 Chronicles 25:1-28

'Therefore consider carefully how you listen.' Luke 8:18 NIV

'Amaziah was twenty-five years old when he became king, and he reigned in Jerusalem for twenty-nine years. His mother's name was Jehoaddin; she was from Jerusalem. He did what was right in the eyes of the Lord, but not wholeheartedly. After the kingdom was firmly in his control, he executed the officials who had murdered his father the king. Yet he did not put their sons to death, but acted in accordance with what is written in the Law, in the Book of Moses, where the Lord commanded: "Fathers shall not be put to death for their children, nor children put to death for their fathers; each is to die for his own sins." 2 Chronicles 25:1-4 NIV

'Fathers shall not be put to death for their children, nor children put to death for their fathers; each is to die for his own sin.' Deuteronomy 24:16 NIV

...also hired a hundred thousand fighting men from Israel for a hundred talents of silver,' 2 Chronicles 25:6 NIV

'But a man of God came to him and said, "O king, these troops from Israel must not march with you, for the Lord is not with Israel—not with any of the people of Ephraim. 'When Amaziah returned from slaughtering the Edomites, he brought back the gods of the people of Seir. He set them up as his own gods, bowed down to them and burned sacrifices to them. The anger of the Lord burned against Amaziah, and he sent a prophet to him, who said, "Why do you consult this people's gods, which could not save their own people from your hand?" 2 Chronicles 25:14-15 NIV
