

- 7. 1 Peter 4:10-11 explains that each of us has received special talents or gifts for what purpose? How can you use your talents to help others?
- 8. What will happen when more and more people come to Christ, according to 2 Corinthians 4:15? How do you feel about the person/event that first brought you to Christ?
- 9. Read Ephesians 3:21. How might this influence someone's decision to join God's family?
