

3. Why do so many people today choose the broad way even when the Jesus says it ends in destruction? What can we do to warn and persuade them to change ways?

4. Compare John 3:19-21 and John 8:12. Share you salvation story as to when God broke into your life and you saw the light.

5. Life has its challenges and difficulties and Christians are not immune from that. How does Proverbs 4:11-12 and Psalm 37:23-24 encourage you. Give some personal examples of how you have seen God do that in your life.

6. Read Philippians 2:15. Many Christians often just exist in their journey instead of enjoying it. Why is that? What can we do to move from just existing day by day to enjoying each day with God?

7. Proverbs 4:18 NKJV describes heaven as the perfect day. What encourages you and what are you looking forward to when you arrive in heaven? How might that spur you on to live each day well?
