Over the next six weeks, we'll learn to love God's Word with our hearts, to learn God's Word with our minds, and to live God's Word with our souls. 6. Share a time when God's Word kept you strong through a difficult season. Agree that studying the Bible gives you a firm foundation to weather the storms of life.
