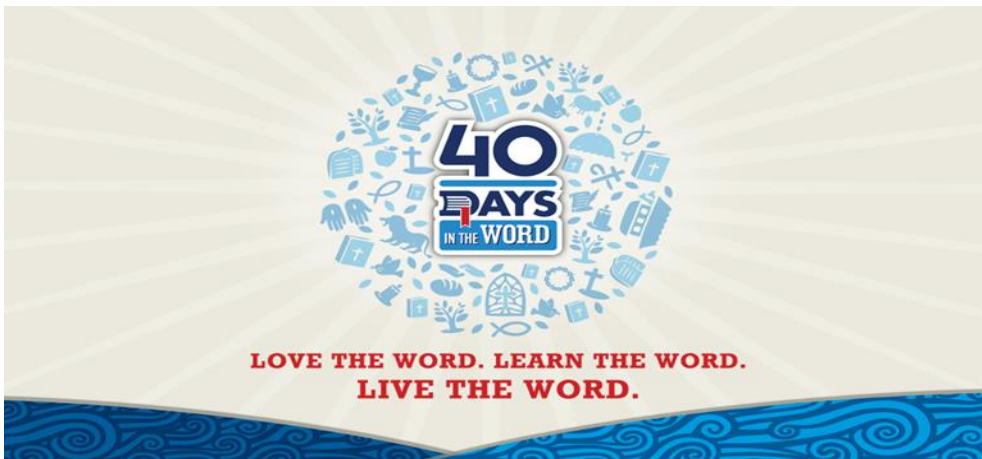

6. It has _____ all attacks.

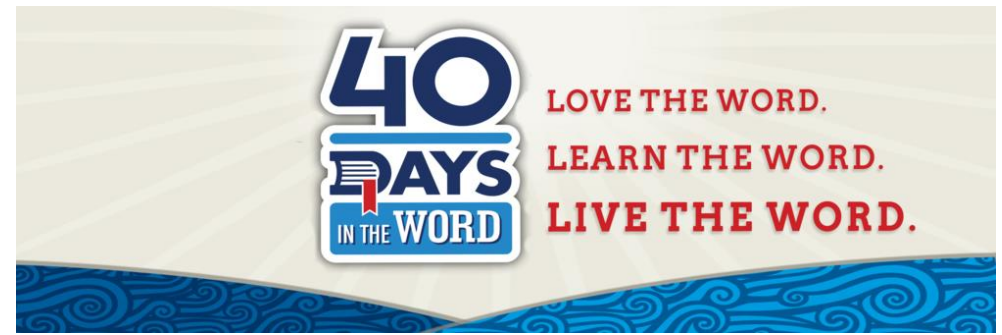
"Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away."
