Thirst ~4 The surprising secret to spiritual growth John 13:1-17

THE EXAMPLE OF JESUS:

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1. Jesus 'For even I, the Son of Man, came here not to be served but to serve others, and to give my life as a ransom for many.' Matthew 20:29 NLT
2. Jesus about serving.
'On the way they [the disciples] had argued about who was the greatest. He [Jesus] sat down and called them around Him and said, 'Anyone wanting to be the greatest must be the least – the servant of all!" Mark 9:33-35 NIV
3. Jesus used parables and stories toserving. 'Then a despised Samaritan came along, and when he saw the man, he felt compassion for him. Going over to him, the Samaritan soothed his wounds with olive oil and wine and bandaged them. Then he put the man on his own donkey and took him to an inn, where he took care of him.' Luke 10:33-34 NLT
'Jesus told him, "Go and do likewise." Luke 10:37 NIV
4. Jesus service.
'Jesus knew the hour had come to leave the world and return to His

Father. He now showed the disciples the full extent of His love... So he got up from the table, took off His robe, wrapped a towel around His waist,

and poured water into a basin. Then He began to wash the disciples' feet and to wipe them with the towel He had around Him... 'I have given you an example to follow. Do as I have done to you." John 13:1,4,5,15 NLT
