2. Who initiates love? See 1 John 4:19. • We really can't love others until we first experience God's unconditional love. Describe a time when God's love changed a situation, or it changed you.

3. According to 1 John 4:16, what is the best way to respond to God's love? • What keeps a person from receiving God's love? • How can we overcome our reluctance or inability to trust that God loves us?

4. There are times in all relationships-spouse, children, parents, friends-when we don't feel very loving towards the other individual. How can we choose to demonstrate love for that person during those seasons, in spite of how we feel? • What action do you think can help rekindle a lost love?

5. What should characterize our love, according to 1 John 3:18? • How will others see God in us? • How can we put love into action so that Christians will be known by their love?

6. What two things are we commanded to do with regard to love, according to 1 Timothy 4:15? In the heat of the moment, even the most careful of us can say or do something unloving. Why is it important not to give up after a stumble when trying to learn love? •Share some of the challenges of trying to learn love; then take a moment to discuss the rewards.

7. What is the love challenge issued in Luke 6:32? • Discuss the habits that would help us love in a way that demonstrates God's love for others. • It's easy to get discouraged when our loving actions are rebuffed. How can the example of Jesus working in our own lives help us persist in reaching out to others?
