

- 6. According to Romans 6:13, for what purpose should we offer our lives?
- 7. In Matthew 6:33, what does it say we should seek first as our primary concern? Why would God give us all we need if we live for him and make his kingdom our primary concern?
- 8. Read Proverbs 3:5-6. What should we do so the Lord will make all our paths straight?
- 9. According to Psalm 37:18-19, what are the benefits of obeying the Lord?
- 10. According to Mark 10:29-30, if one gives up anything for Jesus and to share the Gospel, how much will he be given in the world to come?
