and ever shall be: world without end. Amen

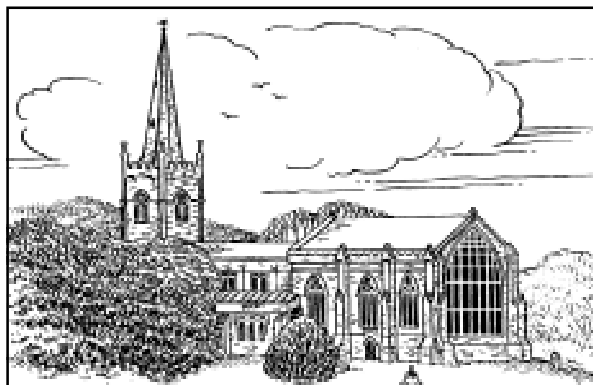
DRONFIELD PARISH CHURCH WEBSITE
