**DRONFIELD PARISH CHURCH WEBSITE**

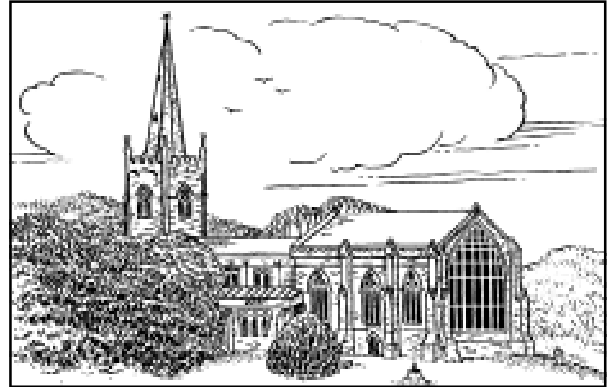
