**TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES** - Derby Diocese is offering two training days as follows:

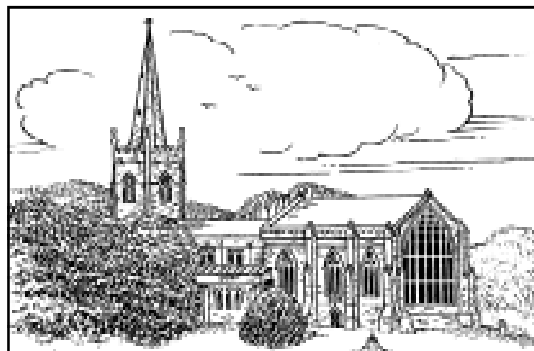
Wed. Nov 7th. 7-9.30pm **Basic First Aid training** cost £20. Venue St Marks Church, Brampton.
