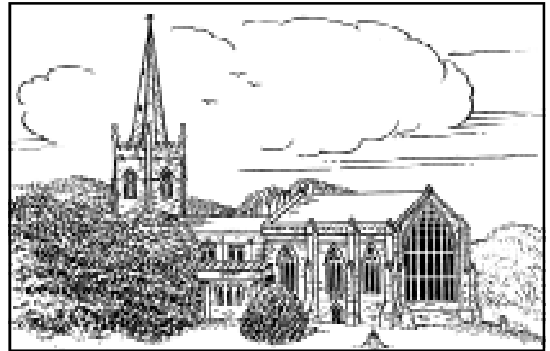

‘Lest We Forget ‘ Armistice 100 - Sunday Nov 11th

Dronfield Church Bells and Dronfield Handbell Ringers will be joining ringers nationwide to mark this special occasion.

10.30am. Remembrance Day ringing on half muffled tower bells, prior to the start of the open air Civic Service.

12.30pm Open ringing (not muffled) to mark 100 years since the signing of the Armistice. This to coincide with ringing at towers across the country and the Cenotaph march-past.

12.30pm Dronfield Handbell Ringers ringing in The Barn courtyard, as their contribution to the occasion.

7.03pm. St Johns Church Bells will ring out and the Handbell Ringers will be ringing in Sindelfingen Park as the Beacon is lit to commemorate 100 years since the end of the First World War.
