be, world without end. Amen

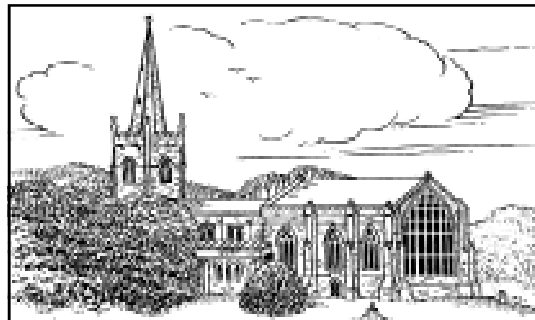
BARN DANCE Saturday 2nd February 7pm in the
