

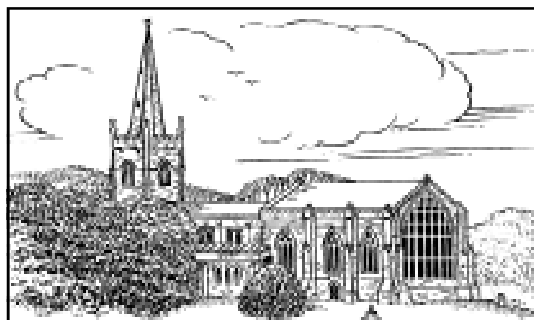
Psalm 36 vv5-10
