MONDAYS 6-7PM FROM 21<sup>ST</sup> JAN 2019

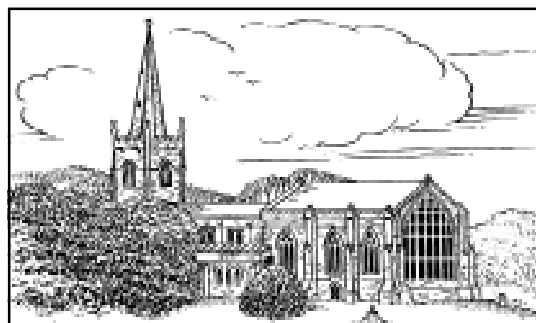
