

Psalm 1

DRONFIELD PARISH YOUNG VOICES

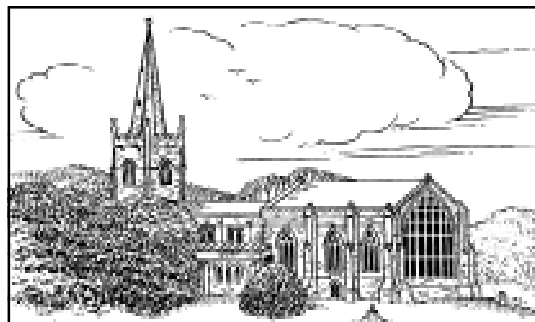
