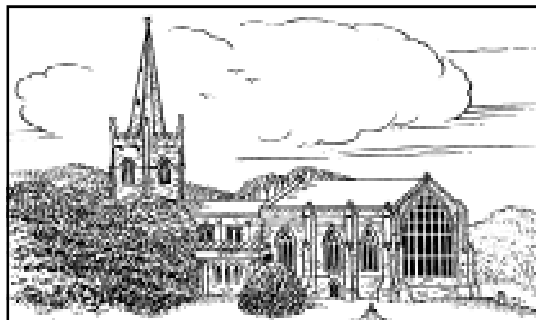

CROSS OF CHRIST - Words and Music for Palm Sunday - April 14th. At 6:30pm the Church Choir will lead a special service to mark the beginning of Holy Week.
