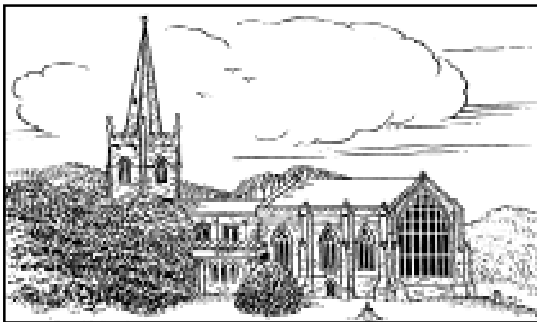

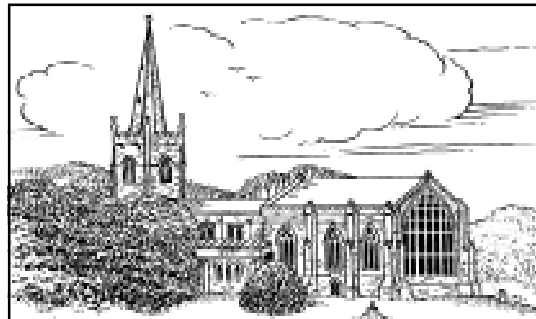
ARTS & CRAFTS THRO' THE AGES
