his splendour above earth and heaven.

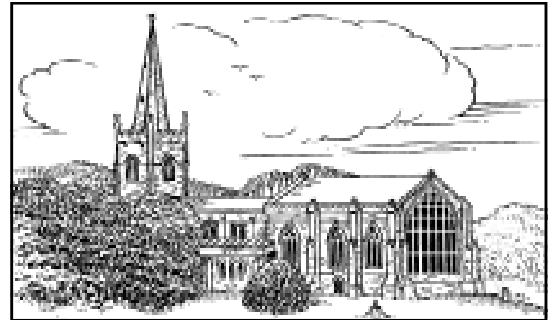
