A coach is leaving St Philips at 2.30pm. If you would like to go please ring Janice 417448 as soon as possible to enable her to book the size of coach required.

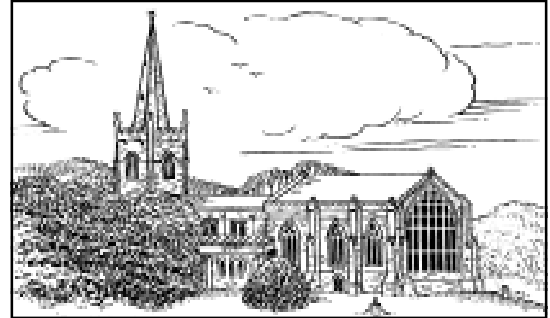
