SERVICES AT THE GREEN CARE HOME

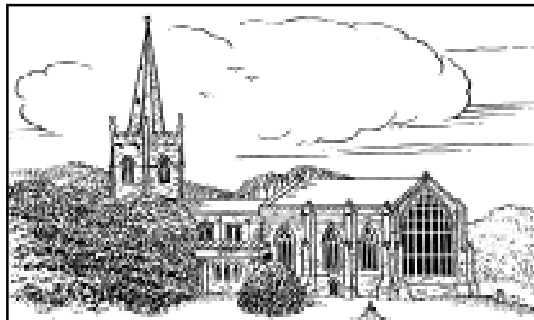
On her retirement from Reader responsibilities Christine Williams handed me the baton for services at The Green Care Home.
