To discuss plans for disabled toilet

On Wednesday 10th July the DCC and Re-ordering Group are holding an open consultation event for everyone interested in decisions about plans for Re-ordering generally and particularly about the siting of disabled toilet facilities.

We are now at the point where clear decisions have to be made by the end of July so we can go to the Diocese in October to get permission to start work on our agreed plans to improve toilet and kitchen facilities in church. On Wednesday 10th there will be a chance to -

- see and walk through current plans
- hear about and ask questions about three potential options for carrying out the plan, including the pros and cons for each.
- have your say about which option you would prefer.

Our architect, Carl Andrews, will be present with Peter and members of the DCC to answer questions.
