Who holds our souls in life and suffers not our feet to slip.

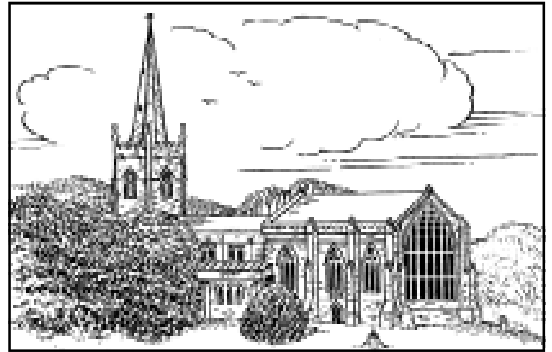
For you, O God, have proved us; you have tried us as silver is tried.
