CHRISTMAS CONCERT**

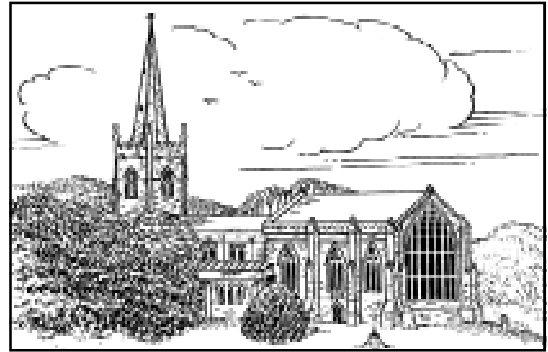
**SATURDAY 14th DECEMBER 7:00pm**
