APPEALS FOR HELP

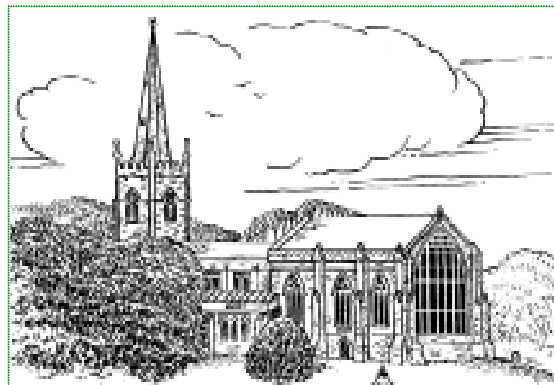
Count Team. Each Sunday evening a team of
