The team

We have an amazing team of volunteers who all help make the youth work at Barley Hill happen. They are all DBS checked and attend regular child protection training, and are awesome as well! We'd all love to meet you, get to know you and hang out with you here at Barley Hill!

What's On

Here's just a snapshot of our main events that we do here at Barley Hill:



Base is the part of the Children's & Youth ministry which happens most Sunday mornings as part of the Barley Hill Sunday morning service. The service begins at 10:30am and the young people will usually head to their groups about 5 or 10 minutes later. Yellow Base is for anyone in school years 7-9 and is a fun, interactive time where we study the Bible and discover more about God, whilst eating food & playing games. Once a month Yellow Base youth sit in church

The Underground is our youth event run by youth, for youth. It is overseen by the youth team but topics, worship, games and all activities are set-up and organised by young people. We meet on the first and third Sunday of the month at Christchurch. The evening starts at 7pm, and finishes at 8:30pm for those in school years 7-9. We carry on until 9:30pm for those in school years 10+ for a time of discussion and questions. It's a really relaxed space, perfect for your friends and great for those people new to Christianity or wanting to find out more.





We meet on the first and third Tuesday of each month to worship together. Whether it's a chance to hone your musical skills, or you just want to come and spend some time worshipping we'd love you to join us. We meet from 7:30-9pm at St Catherine's church in Towersey.

DISCIPLESHIP GROUPS 11-18 Our discipleship groups are all about looking at what it means to be a Christians, exploring what the Bible says, and practicing it. We have two discipleship groups. For young people in school years 7-9, we meet on the first & third Wednesday of every month in Christchurch on the High Street from 7:30-9pm. For young people in school years 10+, we meet on the first & third Thursday of every month, at Nick's house, from 7:30pm. These groups are a great space to learn more about God and explore some of the bigger questions of life and faith.

What better incentive to get through a Monday school day than the thought of a warm cup of coffee (or ice cold cooler) at the end of the day. Each Monday during term time, Nick will be at Costa Coffee from 4-5pm. Ready to chat about anything, talk about any issue, hang out & have a laugh; and also importantly, buy you a drink. Drop in, bring your friends, celebrate surviving Monday!




Other events
