All Souls Time of Remembering and Thanksgiving

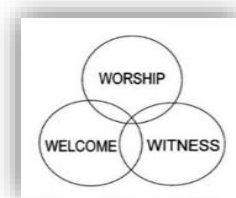
You are invited to our All Souls Time of Remembering and Thanksgiving on **Sunday 30th October, 4.00pm at Holy Trinity Church.**
